At the same time, Oxygen Phone Manager II allows a full-scale interactive access to phone content. You can use PC as a terminal to edit and send out messages, create or import contacts, access and modify multimedia content. The program is a go-between that immediately translates content changes between two operating systems.”

Oxygen Phone Manager II presents the content of a phone in the way familiar to all Windows users. They can access contacts, calendar, to-dos and the gallery from a tree of



expandable folders. The details panel of the phone browser shows the file size and attributes. It also shows the overall size and number of images, melodies and video clips, and their drive mapping (local, flash card or ROM). Separate windows show contacts, calendar items and to-dos. The fields accessible from menus and submenus in Symbian media appear in one grid and are easy to revise. Besides, contacts are available in a vCard edit window. A customary Outlook-style interface provides access to Unicode SMS, MMS, e-mail, BIO and other messages. It offers many options you come to expect from an email service, including a file attachment support, a reply with the original message included, a one-click attachment playback, and others. On the whole, Oxygen Phone Manager II makes managing content of a smartphone easier and faster. Moreover, it protects your personal data and brings integrity into contacts, schedules and plans.

Oxygen Phone Manager II runs under Windows 98 SE/ME/XP/2000/2003 Server platforms and costs 35 EUR (41 USD) for a single-user license, 59 EUR (69 USD) for a family license and 89 EUR (104 USD) for a business license. All registered users are entitled to free technical support and one-year upgrades.
